PATACH-CHET ENDING

When we read a Hebrew syllable, we first say the sound of the letter then the sound of the vowel. But when we read patach chet at the end of a word, we first say the vowel and then we say the letter. It is like there is a patach alef before the chet. So instead of 'cha' we say 'ach'. This is called a 'Patach genuvah'.
