

Occasionally, texts include words with vowels that are beyond what the children have learned. We present these vowels in gray text to communicate that the children may need support to decode these words.



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

When the letter vov is attached to the beginning of a word, it means 'and'. It connects two or more words.

Vov is a conjunction. A conjunction connects two words. The symbol for a conjunction is a pink bar that represents a link in a chain:

COGNATES

Cognates are words from different languages that have similar spellings, pronunciations, and meanings.

Sometimes it's because the Hebrew word was borrowed from English (like puzzle or banana) and other times it's because the English word originated from Hebrew (like cable or sack).
